

## **Catlin Bank Name Change FAQ's**

### **Why did the name of the bank change?**

As of close of business on June 27, 2017 we converted our National Bank charter to an Illinois State Charter. So naturally we cannot use "National" in our bank's name. Beginning on June 28, 2017 our new name will be **Catlin Bank**.

### **How will this change affect me as a customer?**

All accounts will continue without change. The bank ABA routing number will not change. You can keep using your checks until they run out. You can continue using your Debit/ATM cards until they expire or we send you a new one. All existing loan and deposit documents are still binding so there will be no need to change or update them. You will begin to see the new bank name "**Catlin Bank**" on newly ordered checks, debit cards, bank forms and signage. We will answer the phone "**Catlin Bank**".

### **Will this change affect the FDIC insurance on my accounts?**

The deposit insurance coverage will not change because we remain a fully insured bank by the F.D.I.C.

### **Is the Bank being acquired?**

No, there will be no changes in the bank's ownership, management or employees as a result of the charter change.

### **Will the features of my accounts remain the same?**

Yes, your accounts will continue with the same features as they are now. All terms and conditions of your account will remain the same.

### **Will my Online Banking and Bill Pay change?**

No, your Online Banking and Bill Pay sign on and features will remain the same.

### **Will the Bank Website change?**

No, the website [www.catlinbank.com](http://www.catlinbank.com) will remain the same.
